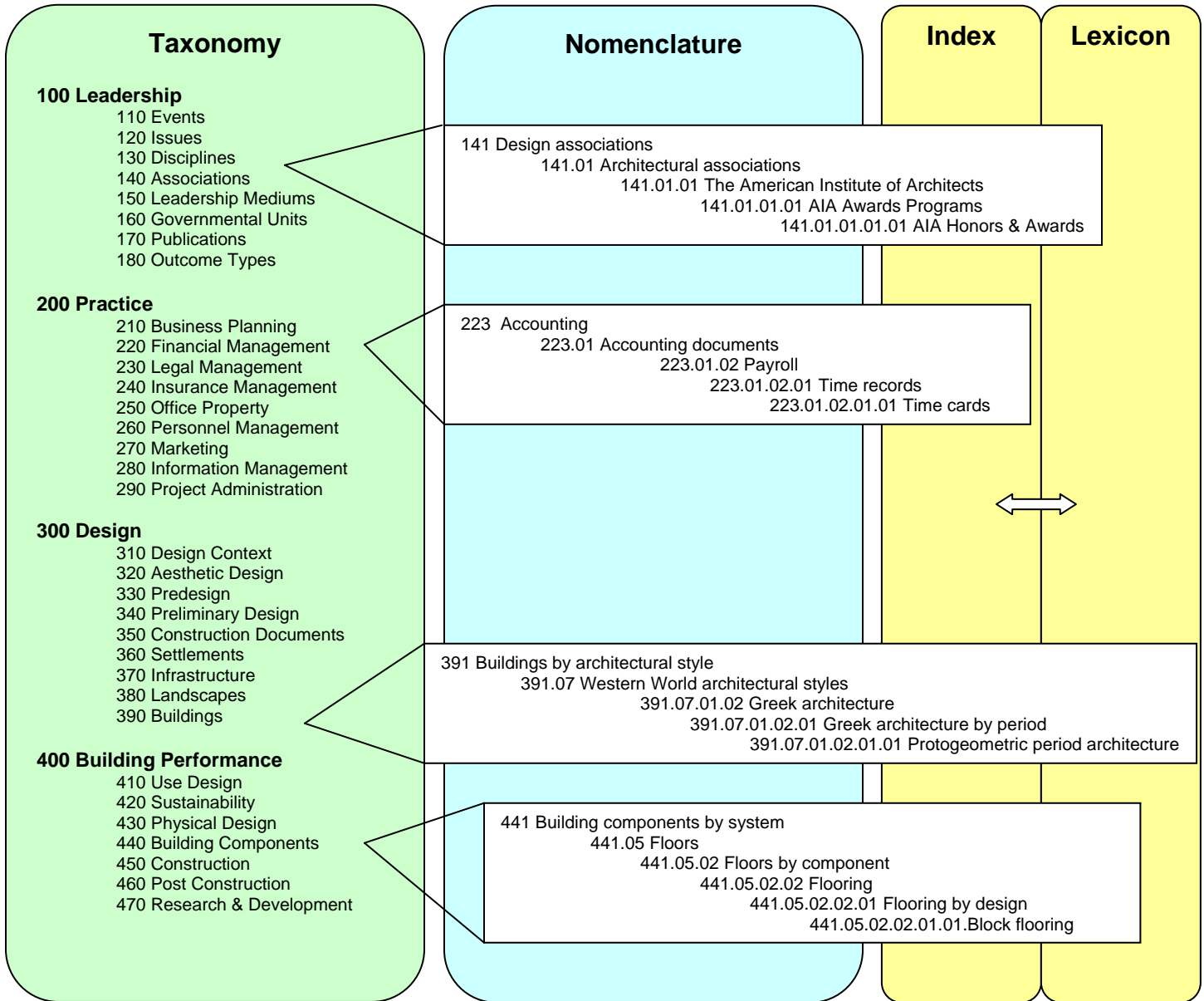


One AIA Classification System

Taxonomy

1. Science of classification

Nomenclature

1. Collection of words or terms or system of names
2. Any specified system of naming

Index

1. Pointer
2. Alphabetical table of contents, list of terms.

Lexicon

The complete set of meaningful units in a language; the words, etc., as in a dictionary, but without the definitions.

1. The vocabulary proper to some department of knowledge or sphere of activity; the vocabulary or word-stock of a region, a particular speaker, etc.
2. A list of words or names.

One AIA Classification System

The four domains (Leadership, Practice, Design, and Building Performance) offer opportunities to share and deliver information to your fellow professionals in an organized manner. These domains enhance dynamic knowledge creation and expansion that enrich the profession and its culture. When submitting materials, please select the domain that you think *best represents the content category of your piece*. The domains used for organizing the material are described below.

- **Leadership**

This domain covers leadership knowledge that inspires changes and transformations in thinking and practice, including issues of society, firms and organizational entities.

- **Practice**

The Practice track includes the processes, procedures and policies involved in running a firm/project and creating a safe and sustainable built environment that protects the health, safety and welfare of the public, including project delivery systems, contracts and agreements and intellectual property, ethics and risk management as they are practiced within firms, corporations, government agencies and other organizations.

- **Design**

The Design domain includes planning a project, either new building or existing, from concept design through design development and documentation.

- **Building Performance**

The Building Performance domain focuses on systems integration, materials and methods, operations, and metrics of a viable building that contributes to a healthy work and living space.
